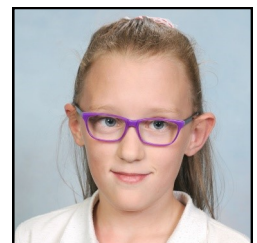

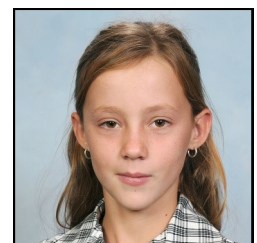

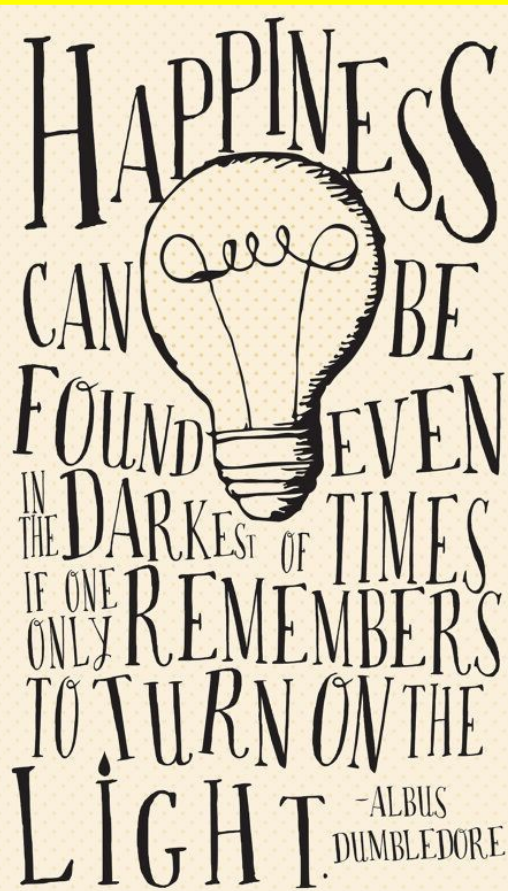

When you buy 2 books, you will receive 1 book to the same value or less for free. Students will then choose another book to the same value or less and will donate it back into the library.

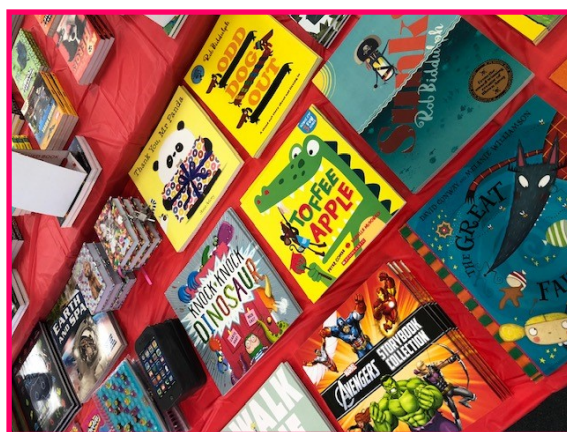
Only the stock we have on hand is for sale - we are unable to place orders for this event.
